### RE: CATHERINE HILL BAY EPBC (2008/4419) ANNUAL COMPLIANCE 2024-25

MJD Environmental has been engaged by Wallalong Land Developments Pty Ltd to prepare an annual compliance report for the 2024-25 period detailing the measures undertaken to address approval conditions granted under the Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act) for the Catherine Hill Bay Development (EPBC No. 2008/4419 – Annexure B of the consolidated approval) on the 23 March 2010 (consolidated 28 November 2016).

This report includes an overview of all of the conditions associated with the approval and the commencement of the development. MJD Environmental note that the project commencement to date is limited to underscrubbing of site vegetation to facilitate detailed land survey, and as such many requirements of the Development Management Plan have not commenced or cannot be implemented as construction activities are yet to commence.

The current status of each condition of approval is summarised in Table 1 below.



## Approval of Variation and Catherine Hill Bay Development Management Plan

Dear Mr Nicholson

Thank you for your email dated 11 July 2023 and 6 October 2023 to the department requesting the variation of conditions attached to the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act* 1999 (EPBC Act) approval for Catherine Hill Bay development, and approval of the draft Catherine Hill Bay Development Management Plan as required under condition B3 of the approval.

Officers of this department have reviewed the variation request. As delegate of the Minister for the Environment and Water, I have varied the conditions attached to EPBC Act approval 2008/4419 under section 143(1)(c) of the EPBC Act. This will extend the period of time in which to commence the action. The action must now be taken in accordance with the varied conditions specified in the variation notification, which has been attached for your information.

Officers of the department have advised me on the development management plan and the requirements of the conditions of the approval for this project. On this basis, and as a delegate of the Minister for the Environment and Water (the Minister), I have decided to approve the Catherine Hill Bay Development Management Plan Flowers Drive, Catherine Hill Bay, NSW, Version 5, November 2023. This plan must now be implemented.

The department notes the Independent Auditor review indicated PFAS and PFOA were unlikely to be contaminants of concern at the site based on previous site uses. Noting that the Remediation Action Plan suggests that further assessment may be required in some cases, such as within surface water, the department recommends that if further sampling is undertaken that it include PFASs, and that the PFAS National Environmental Management Plan is followed.

Approval condition B11 for this project allows you (under certain circumstances) to implement revised plans without seeking approval from the Minister. If you require any advice on whether to submit a revised plan for approval, please contact the Post Approvals area. I also attach a fact sheet providing guidance on new or increased impact relating to changes to approved management plans under EPBC Act.

As you are aware, the department has an active monitoring program which includes monitoring inspections, desk top document reviews and audits. Please ensure that you maintain accurate

Thank you for your correspondence dated 23 February 2024 notifying the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (the department) of commencement of the action reference EPBC 2008/4419, in accordance with *the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) approval.

### RE: ECOLOGICAL PRE-CLEARANCE- 1A FLOWERS DRIVE, CATHERINE HILL BAY

MJD Environmental was engaged by Monteath & Powys Pty Ltd on behalf of DEMA NSW to provide ecological pre-clearance and compliance to their civil contractor Wallalong Land Developments Pty Ltd for tree removal works as part of ongoing residential subdivision at Catherine Hill Bay.

#### Pre-clearance

Pre-clearance surveys of the area were undertaken by MJD Ecologists on the 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup> of February 2024 and on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2024. All habitat trees to be removed were flagged with pink flagging tape, marked with three large 'H's in pink spray paint (where tree trunk girth allowed) and recorded on a handheld GPS to allow for easy identification during vegetation removal works (refer to **Attachment 1**).

The site boundary was observed to be demarcated using bright pink flagging tape and star pickets, indicating the extent of works (refer to **Attachment 2**).


On the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 2024, areas known to contain records of Black-eyed Susan (*Tetratheca Juncea*) adjacent to the site boundaries in the West and Northwest were flagged with orange flagging tape to minimise potential impact during vegetation clearance (refer to **Attachment 3**). Care must be taken during clearance works in these areas to ensure populations of *T. Juncea* are not damaged or compromised.

### **Contractor Inductions**


An Environmental Induction Record was created on the 19<sup>th</sup> of February 2024 to highlight and ensure compliance with relevant management plan matters, including:

- Equipment hygiene
- Erosion control
- How clearing boundaries are demarcated
- Location of the VMP/Conservation Area
- Clearing boundary and demarcation by flicker tape (i.e., Go / No-Go zones)
- Staged clearing protocols
- Felling of non-habitat trees away from retained vegetation off site; away from retained habitat trees
- Contacts to be called if an animal is found on site and is injured or requires assistance













 Clearing methods – climbing arborist to sectionally dismantle trees and/or soft felling by machinery



# **HBT CLEARANCE MAP**




